**A Guide for  
Higher Rate Taxpayers**

**How to make your giving  
worth even more than  
28% extra**

*giftaid it*

Gift Aid is a method by which you can give a sum of money and this church can reclaim from the HM Revenue and Customs the basic rate of tax on your donation, plus the transitional relief given in the Budget 2008.

That increases the value of the gift you make to this church by just over 28%,

For example, every £100 given via Gift Aid increases in value to £128

Subject to a few rules you can give any amount, large or small, regularly or one-off and the church can reclaim the tax.

For a donor who pays tax at the higher rate of 40%, the church can only reclaim tax at the basic rate (plus transitional relief).

However the remaining 20% may then be claimed back by the donor from HMRC as marginal tax relief.

This remaining 20% can also be donated to the Church when you make your tax return. A form to do this is sent in the tax return pack or can be ordered from HMRC.

### **What to Do!**

Please complete a Gift Aid Form, which you can obtain from our Gift Aid Officer.

You can give via Standing Order, Cheque or envelopes.

Our Gift Aid Officer or Treasurer will do the rest, claiming the tax refund on the church's behalf.

All personal information, including sums given, are treated as confidential.

### **Why should I give by Gift Aid?**

We are called by God to be good stewards of all that he gives us, and that includes money. Gift Aid increases the income of this church in a way that costs donors nothing.

Our giving enables and sustains the mission of this church and the People of God in this place.
