Authority Names of various popular deities, eg, Rama Krishna, Ganesh. Stories which show their importance to Hindu believers. Role of the Guru.

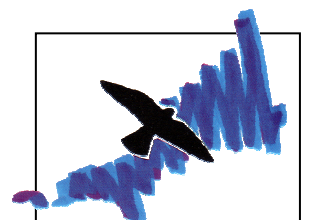
Beliefs Dharma – family responsibilities and rules. Upholding religion, values and rituals in the home. God worshipped in different forms.

Symbols Objects used in worship, eg Arti lamp, Puja tray. Aum.

Lifestyles Dharma – Performing one's religious duties.

Stages of Life Upanayana (sacred thread) ceremony. Weddings

Natural World Respect for all living things. Vegetarianism. Stories of kindness to animals



Relationships Arranged marriages, role in the family, religious duties of the family members. How Varna and Jati (caste) influence human respect and relationship.
