EVALUATING ACCOMPANIED MINISTRY DEVELOPMENT (AMD)

Researchers from York St John University have been funded by the St Luke's College Foundation (Registered Charity number 306606) to evaluate the Accompanied Ministry Development programme in the Diocese of Truro. The research project began in March 2015 and runs until September 2017. The lead researcher is Dr Andrew Village, Professor of Practical and Empirical Theology at York St John University; and the Postdoctoral Research Assistant on the project is Dr Judith A. Muskett. The research is overseen by an Academic Panel, with some members external to the diocese (including from Church House Westminster).

OCCASIONAL PAPERS

The researchers are required to submit written reports to the Diocese from time to time.

The Diocese will share key findings from the project reports with participants and staff involved in AMD, and with congregations and the wider Church community. In part, this will be achieved through a series of short 'Occasional Papers'.
